This management system applicability matrix is used to define the specific standard requirements that apply to each EQMS process/function in the organization and can be used to inform each process owner of the requirements that they must comply with. It is also used to guide internal auditors on what requirements should be covered during each internal audit. An example is Document Control (7.5); every process has some responsibility but the Document Controller normally manages document control and has primary responsibility.
